The 2020 COVID-19 GOLF SEASON

Due to the virus, there was no organizational meeting since the Park District Buildings were closed. We also did not know at that time if the Park District golf course would be open.

In May, the governor announced that golf courses could open with the following restrictions: only two golfers were allowed on the course every 15 minutes; only one person per cart unless they were members of the same household; and no pull carts were allowed to be rented. Available tee times were limited, with the last tee time no later than 10:45.

The Schaumburg Golf Club closed the clubhouse to the public and enacted the following procedures. An outdoor starter's house was set up for the payment of golf fees and to sign up for the following week. During the month of May scorecards and pencils were not available. There were no benches, ball washers, bunker rakes or water stations. A plastic insert was placed in the hole to prop up the ball since we were not allowed to remove the flag stick. The Halfway House, driving range and practice putting greens were also closed during May.

All the restrictions and closings had an impact on the normal operations of our league. Since there was no organizational meeting, Kathy Johnson put together an e-mail list of all members to keep everyone informed of league status and happenings. We began golfing the second Tuesday in May. Due to the restrictions, not all members could golf every week. With the number of registered golfers, the league was divided into three groups, with each golfer scheduled at least once every three weeks, and no more than twice.

In June, restrictions were eased, and we were able to have foursomes teeing off every ten minutes once again. The clubhouse, driving range, and putting greens were once again open. Scorecards were again provided, but due to the uncertainty about the virus, the league decided not to keep and record scores. Therefore there were no special events or chip-ins. Every week was just open golf with every golfer able to play each week. The year-end banquet was also cancelled due Covid restrictions.

Since there was no need for prize money, all league members were reimbursed \$30 of their \$33 registration fee. The other \$3 went to Schaumburg Park District for processing fees.

The SGC finished their golf enhancement plan with the opening of the Tournament course at the end of July. The entire league then played on only one course each week for the rest of the season. We alternated between the three courses every two weeks.

Going forward into the 2021 golf season, Jonathan Parsons, the General Manager of Golf Operations at the Park District, will be our new league contact person. His office will handle registration, banquet fees, and the printing of the Golfer's Guide.

The league registration letter and membership application will be sent to all 2020 members by e-mail. You will be able to mail your application back, or drop it off at SGC Monday through Friday between 9 AM and 5 PM. The 2021 membership fee will again be \$33.

The organizational meeting is currently scheduled for Tuesday, April 20, 2021, at 1 PM, location yet to be determined. The first day of golf is Tuesday, May 4, 2021. Members will be able to sign up for the first week of golf at the SGC after 3 PM on April 20. The signup sheets will be removed at 3 PM on April 27. Members may request a tee time by sending an e-mail (preferred) to: shseniorsgolfleague@gmail.com. They can also call the Pairing/Tee Time committee before 9 PM on Tuesday, April 27.
